**RATIONALE:** (Describe briefly existing problem and expected benefit of proposed change)

We have lost participation in Master Senior since we allowed all styles. At the 2014 National Indoor (which was the biggest National Indoor in quite some time) we had 29 fewer Master Seniors than 2013 while offering all the different styles. Outdoors is harder to compare with the differences in turnouts for the different locations but the numbers speak for themselves.

Currently we are providing a bowl for simply being 70+ and showing up in four different styles at the last 3 Nationals (the last Indoor and the last two Outdoors).

In the past, if you shot Master Senior and you wanted to shoot a style other than Freestyle, Limited Freestyle and Barebow, you had to shoot against much younger shooters and shoot Senior. We created a 60+ Silver Senior which has all the styles that Adult and Senior have. Master Senior archers who want to shoot specific styles can shoot Silver Senior.

Change Master Senior back to Freestyle, Limited Freestyle and Barebow only.

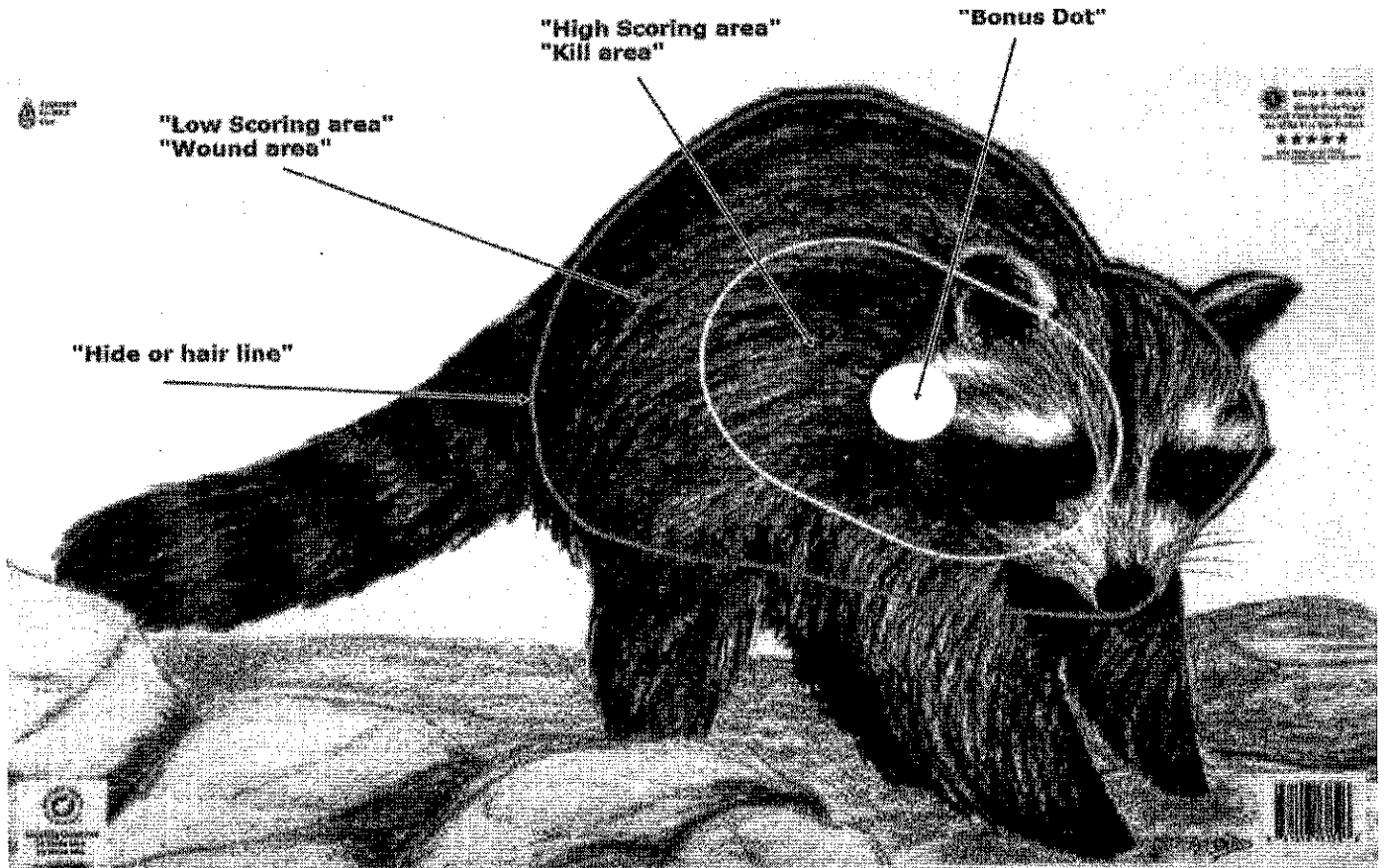
